4:15

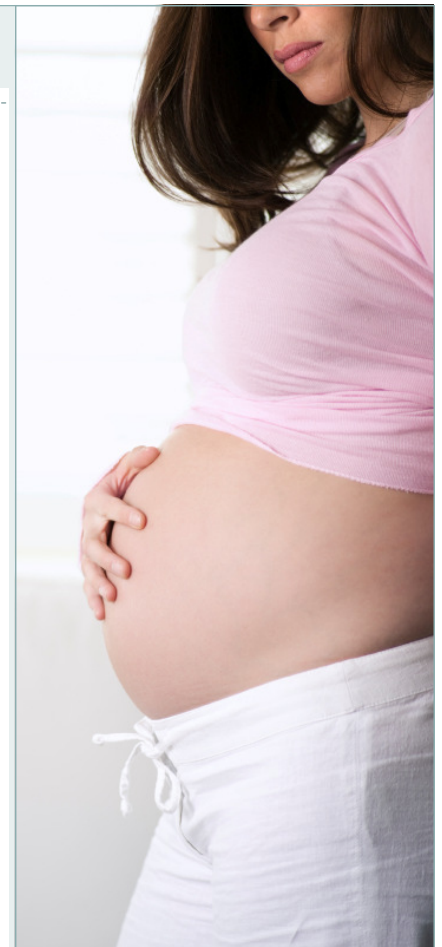

Our current requirement for items in the Friendship Room is a one page Bible study. These Bible studies have opened up many doors regarding spiritual discussions that we may not have had otherwise. Our dream to increase our scope of influence is to be able to have space where women can come into the Center and have a conversation over a cup of coffee. As we show these women that we care and

are concerned about them, we can build deeper relationships with them.

We also hope to implement the “*Earn While You Learn*” program and open a “*Baby Store*”. This is similar to our Friendship Room, but instead of a “*give-away*” closet, women are able to take classes that earn them “*Baby Bucks*.” They use these “*Baby Bucks*” to buy items in the “*Baby Store*.” We are convinced this program will take women from an entitlement mentality to an empowerment mentality. We want to implement this program into our Center, but that would require a bigger space and a larger facility overall.
